Little Hula Girl



Materials:

- 1 springless clothespin
- 1 tan pipe cleaner
- 1 small piece of green felt
- black or brown yarn
- scrap of brown construction paper
- scrap of fabric, yellow or pink
- glue, scissors, and fine point marker
- magnet (optional)

Directions:

1. Cut 2 inch pieces of thread, unravelling to create 'hair' .
2. Cut 1-inch strip of felt, and the cut fringes to create a grass skirt as pictured.
3. Cut brown circles from paper for coconuts. Alternately, use tiny brown pom-poms.
4. Wind tan pipe cleaner around clothespin to create arms as shown.
5. Glue on skirt, coconuts, and hair as shown using hot glue or tacky glue.
6. Cut scrap of fabric very thin, until it kinks. Use it to create a tiny lei.
7. Draw face with fine-tip marker.
8. Hula girl can stand on her "legs", or glue magnet on back. (optional).
