Recycled Stationery



Kideas Tip: To make a recycled envelope, simply take an envelope of the desired size and disassemble it carefully to use for a pattern. Trace around the envelope on your brown bag (or other paper), cut, and fold! Don't forget to save the disassembled envelope to use for a pattern for subsequent envelopes!

Also rubber stamping works beautifully on these embellished cards.

Materials:

- used greeting cards, wrapping paper, postcards, etc.
- brown paper grocery bags
- scissors
- glue
- fine point markers
- ribbons, embellishments, etc.

Directions:

1. Cut out images from old, used greeting cards.
2. Cut sections of paper bag in the desired size for the new card.
3. Glue cutouts to card, and finish with embellishments, messages, ink stitch border, etc.
