"Stained Glass" Butterfly

Materials:

- wax paper
- crayon shavings
- scissors
- iron and ironing board
- hole punch and yarn



Directions:

1. Acquire crayon shavings by using a crayon sharpener, knife, or scissors (adult only)
2. Cut the shape of a butterfly out of two sheets of wax paper, folding in half for symmetry. Use the pattern on the next page if desired.
3. Sprinkle crayon shavings onto one layer of wax paper. Experiment with different colors.
4. Lay second layer of wax paper on top of shavings. Carefully transfer to ironing board. An adult can then iron the layers together on medium heat, until wax melts. Use paper towels or scrap fabric to protect iron and ironing board from melted wax.
5. When cool, punch hole in butterfly and thread yarn.
